Purpose of the meeting: to consider ways to connect the work of CareerSource Central Florida to those community based organizations that are seeking ways to connect youth (ages 16-24).

In discussion with CSCF Board members Bill D’Aiuto and Glen Casel, the idea was raised as to how organizations across the region could be more effective in connecting organizations working with youth, ages 16-24 to resources that would enable them not only allow them to connect, short-term to jobs, but also expose them to career paths that would allow them to explore options and opportunities for longer-term career growth and development.

After discussion of the benefits of building a youth network of providers that could link to youth to jobs and careers, it was recommended that CSCF host a meeting in April to identify gaps and opportunities.

The purpose of the meeting: to discuss how CSCF can assist other organizations in connecting young people (16-24) to jobs and careers.
