

**Annual Renewal of Registered Apprenticeship Program –
Central Florida Electrical Joint Apprenticeship
Program Year – July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025**

CareerSource Central Florida (CSCF) agrees to continue and support Central Florida Electrical Alliance registered apprenticeship program enrollment of Incumbent Worker Electricians who qualify and live within our region.

Approval and enrollment of individuals will be based on the available budget during the program year and will require maintaining a performance level of 75% or above in retention of employment and 50% completion of training.

CSCF will continue to support individuals by offering pre-approved support services for 2nd and 3rd year apprentices who advance to the next level to complete their program of study:

- Up to \$2,000 per year for 2nd year students
- Up to \$1,600 per year for 3rd year students

Central Florida Electrical Alliance will continue to keep CSCF team updated on each individual / apprentice's training and employment status.

Central Florida Electrical Alliance agrees to meet these expectations and CSCF agrees to support all eligible individuals enrolled.

This agreement is effective July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.
